SOME 120 selected students from four secondary schools in Gelang Patah, Johor, recently took part in a motivational talk for Malaysian Certificate of Education (SPM) students organised by Pelabuhan Tanjung Pelepas Sdn Bhd (PTP).

Started in 2007, to date more than

2,000 local secondary students had benefited from the series.
