

► PTP holds annual UPSR camp for Gelang Patah students



PORT of Tanjung Pelepas (PTP) recently organised a motivational camp for Primary 6 students who will be sitting for their upcoming Ujian Peperiksaan Sekolah Rendah (UPSR) examination in September. The two-day learning camp was aimed at equipping the students with learning techniques and to improve their performance in the examination, to instil confidence and to provide them with invaluable tips, as well as to motivate them to be mentally prepared for their big day. About 130 students along with 20 teachers from 13 primary schools in Gelang Patah participated in the programme that was held at Savannah Hill Resort, Ulu Tiram. The camp is in collaboration between PTP and The National Council of Counseling Teachers of Johor Baru under the Johor Baru Education Department.
